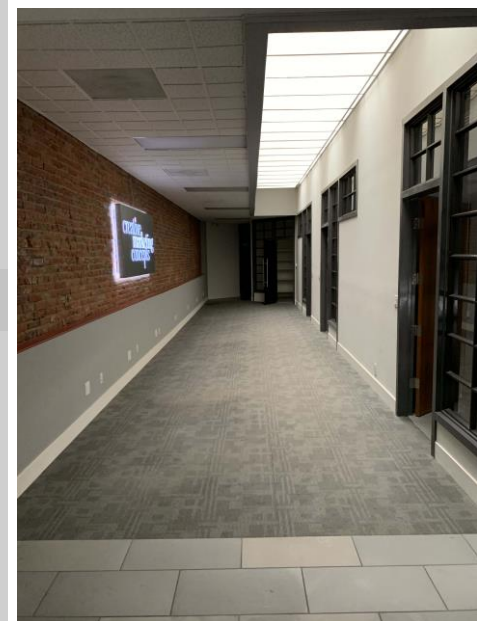

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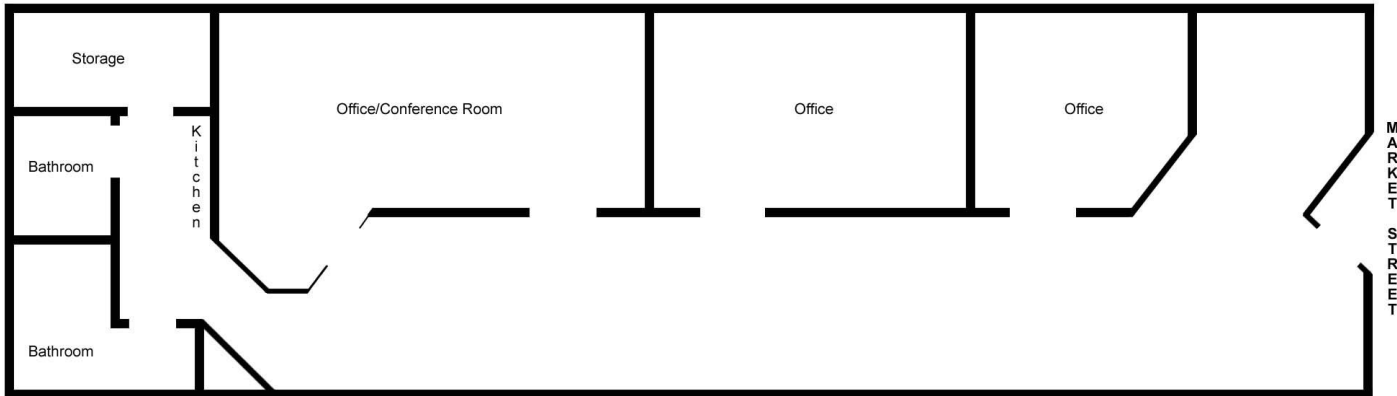

In the identified area, the current year population is 649,329. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 633,964. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.74% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 683,813 representing a change of 1.04% annually from 2013 to 2018. Currently, the population is 50.7% male and 49.3% female.

Currently, 45.8% of the 219,339 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 50.0%, renter occupied; and 4.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 214,530 housing units in the area - 47.5% owner occupied, 47.8% renter occupied, and 4.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.99%. Median home value in the area is \$457,180, compared to a median home value of \$177,257 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 5.14% annually to \$587,526.

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
